## **NVWIT PIPELINE PROGRAM**

### **Pre-Apprenticeship**

NVWIT's *Pipeline Program* core curriculum consists of 150 hours of interactive content, delivered in small group classes 20 hours a week over a six-week period. Pipeline students receive out-of-class assignments, individual coaching, mentoring, and; test taking skills. *Pipeline Students* receive valuable OSHA, CPR, Forklift Certifications during four required Saturday Academies. Additionally, all students participate in site visits, attend presentations by trades representatives; and receive hands-on learning opportunities.

### **NVWIT's Pipeline Program Eligibility Requirements:**

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Current Nevada Driver's License.
- Birth Certificate or other proof of eligibility to work in the United States.
- Demonstrate basic Math and Reading skills on an NVWIT's aptitude test.
- Complete and pass a drug test with documentation provided to NVWIT.
